Dear Prospective Ukraine Volunteer

Your interest in volunteer missions in Ukraine is an exciting step in your Christian journey. God has given us a deep love for the people of Ukraine and has allowed us to coordinate the trips for many teams since 1995. ***Ukraine Challenge International, Inc.*** began in 1999. We have assisted approximately 600 volunteers on about 65 different teams since that time. We would be happy to help you in any way possible catch the vision of volunteer missions. We hope to learn more about you and your specific interest in Ukraine. Please let us know how we can help you.

Teams normally begin work in early June and continue through early August. However, projects at other times can also be arranged. Medical/Dental teams, Children/Youth Camp teams, and Construction/Renovation teams are the most common. These are just the primary tasks for teams. Each team will do other ministry as God opens the doors and as needs arise. Of course, evangelism is the primary goal of any of these teams. If you or others you know would be interested, we have vacancies in almost all teams.

- The total cost is \$2,000, depending on actual airfare. This includes airfares, insurance, and in country meals, translators, transportation, and housing.
- Team members typically stay in the homes of Ukrainian families. A few churches have dorm-type facilities.
- Our invitation comes from the Baptist Union of Ukraine.
- A typical team goes for two weeks, usually leaving the US on Friday or Saturday and arriving in Ukraine on Saturday or Sunday afternoon. A shopping and sight-seeing day in Kiev is scheduled at the team leader and coordinator's discretion. However, the length of the project can be tailored to fit individual circumstances.
- Return trip departure day is normally Saturday. Most teams are taking advantage of a one-day flight.
- Occasionally, there is an overnight stay in some European city at the team's choice and expense on the return trip.

<u> </u> Immediately	Begin spiritual preparation with daily prayer and Bible study.
<u> </u> Immediately	Apply for a passport or check the status of your present passport—renew if necessary.
<u> </u> February 15	Send \$250 Deposit to me at the mailing address below
<u> </u> March 1	Send <i>Ukraine Challenge</i> Application Form to me. (for international insurance)
<u> </u> April 1	Send \$1750 <u>or</u> balance of cost to me.

We hope this gives you enough information to continue your consideration. Please pray about your involvement. **If you are even slightly interested, the first step you need to take is to apply for a USA Passport**, or insure your passport is up to date.
